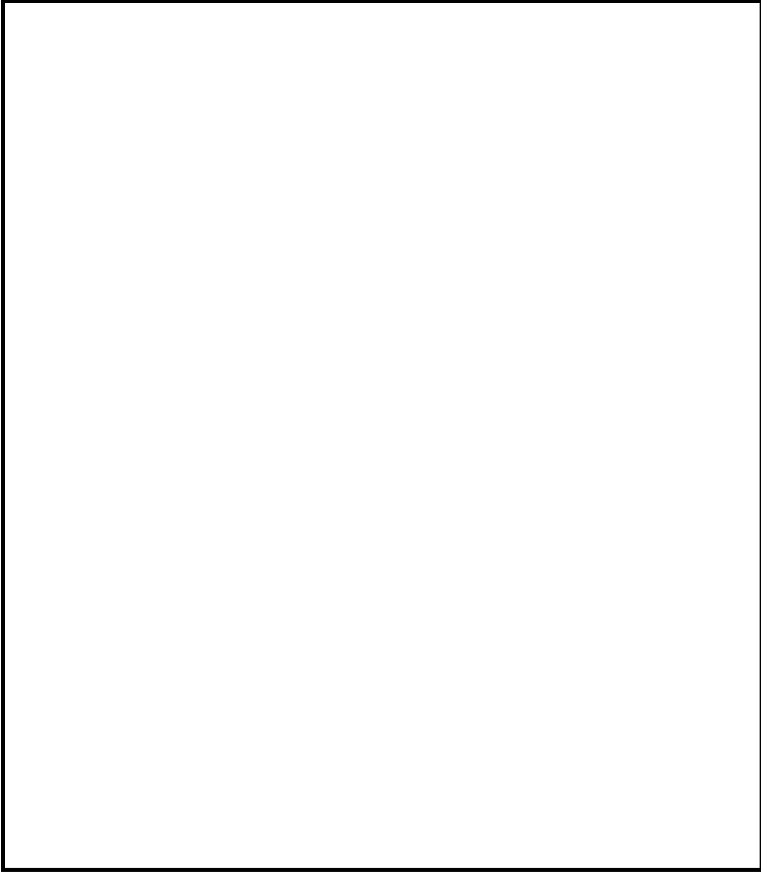
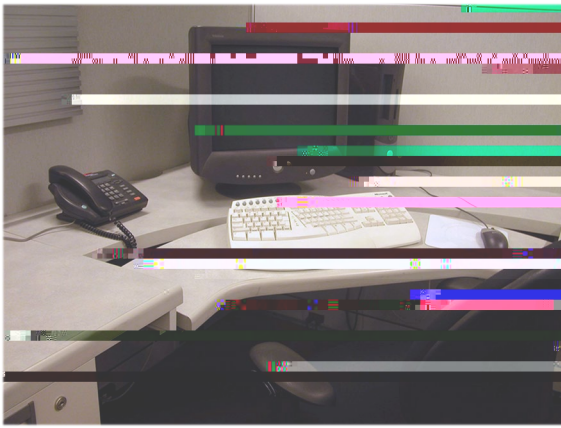


State Performance Plan Indicator 8: Parent Involvement

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NYSED recommends that a variety of strategies be used to ensure success. ***For all strategies, ensuring that parent responses are confidential should be a priority.***

- x Provide a computer in a confidential setting to allow parents to complete the survey online;
- x Distribute surveys at school meetings, such as open houses, conferences, and CSE and CPSE annual meetings;
- x Enlist the assistance of parent advocates;
- x Provide a reader to assist literacy challenged parents;
- x Provide translators if the survey is not available in the language of the parent; and
- x Distribute the survey by mail.

How is the Indicator 8 survey results data calculated?

The number of surveys with an overall positive parental involvement rating (parents indicated that they “agree”, “strongly agree” or “very strongly agree” with at least 51% of the questions)	÷	All surveys returned with at least 15 of the 25 questions answered	X 100 =	# of respondent parents who reported that schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving services and results for children with disabilities
