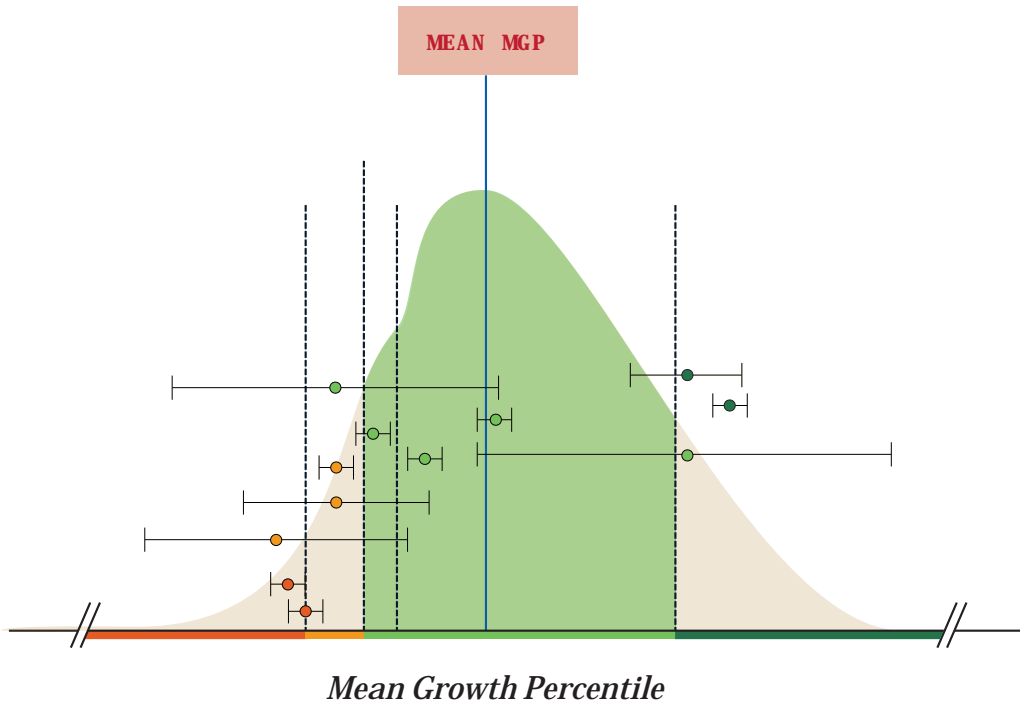




FIGURE 2. HEDI CLASSIFICATION DIAGRAM
