<b>Report Title</b>	<b>Report Description</b>
<i>[Teacher/Principal/School]-Student 4-8.csv</i>	These files may contain multiple records per student. Each student record contains available student growth percentile (SGP) scores for ELA or math for the 2022-2023 school year, plus the historical test scores and other student demographic information used to calculate student growth percentiles. <sup>3</sup>
<i>[ELA/Alg]_student.csv</i>	These files contain one record per student, and the data are used to calculate the Grades 9-12 SGPs, including the historical test scores and other student demographic variables.
<i>GRE_student.csv</i>	This file contains one record per student. Demographic variables and prior Regents assessment history used to calculate Grades 9-12 comparative growth in Regents Examinations passed measure are included in this file.

Additional State-Provided Growth Results

There are up to thirteen (13) data files that include State-provided growth scores and ratings for grades 4-8 teachers, principals, and schools, as well as

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
